## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Pour into free draining containers and allow ad-lib access

Allow one lick station per 50-100 head

Ensure continuous access once supplementation has commenced

Intake may exceed target level until craving for minerals is satisfied

Target intake: 30-60g/head/day

Can be added to grain supplements at the rate of 2.5%

25kg bag, 1mt bulka bag

## DISCLAIMER

Introduce or modify high grain rations gradually to facilitate adaptation

Ensure ad-lib access to fresh clean water
